- ii. Facility Use Request(s)
 - a. JrROTC car wash - approved prior to Council meeting by the Exec Committee. Already done; successful
 - b. All Addictions Recovery Group
 - c. St. Elizabeth's
 - d. Abby Barker - baby shower. Person in the community who wants to use the facility. We would prefer to be more direct with costs of facility use
 - e. Hearts of Hospitality
 - f. Motion made by Allen to approve all the above facility requests; seconded by Morgan. Motion carried unanimously

- iii. Pastor Steve's Crazy Property Idea
 - a. Giving percentage is not 10%. Church financial structure based on 10% tithe.
 - b. Battle between operational support vs ministry resources.
 - c. Accessibility and flexibility needs. We need facilities that multiply ministry.
 - d. Downtown location; downtown needs (parking, meeting spaces, student housing)
 - e. Watauga County Housing Crisis
 - f. Overlapping Needs of Grace and Boone (housing, parking, meeting spaces, student housing)
 - g. Is there a way for Grace to update its property and facilities that meets both the ministry needs of the congregation and the community needs in Boone. Could this be done to be a more sustainable model for ministry moving forward?
 - h. Idea is a large-scale building project that would update and add new buildings to both downtown properties which would be primarily funded by income generated through workforce housing, student housing, office rental space, parking, etc.
 - i. 20 year generational project. Would generate lots of income.
